Anette Lykke Petri has been Director of the Danish Patient Safety Authority since 2020.

She has been employed in the Danish healthcare system from 1999 to 2007, primarily within the surgical, gynecological and oncological specialties. In addition, she has been working with quality development within the healthcare sector. She defended her PhD thesis at the University of Copenhagen in 2009.

In 2011, Anette became a specialist in Public Health Medicine. From 2011 to 2015, she was a Medical Public Health Officer and Chief Physician in The Danish Patient Safety Authority. She has also worked as Acting Chief Medical Officer on The Faroe Islands.

Anette completed a Master of Public Governance (MPG) at Copenhagen Business School in 2018.

Anette has been a member of the epidemic commissions in The Capital Region of Denmark and Region Zealand since 2012 and in the national Epidemic Commission from 2021. In addition, she has participated in board work, including in the European Supervisory Association EPSO.
