Prof Stuart Baird is an Emeritus Professor of Podiatric Medicine at Glasgow Caledonian University and an Adjunct Professor Queensland University of Technology Brisbane Australia. He is a past Dean of the Faculty of Podiatric Medicine, Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow and a past Chairman of the Royal College of Podiatry in London. Additionally, Stuart was Vice President of the International Academy of Podiatric Medical Educators, a subgroup of the FIP.

Stuart has had a special interest in diabetes and its effects on the lower limb and foot for over 30 years. As well as being an academic Stuart was also a clinician and remained clinically active within the multidisciplinary team at the Centre for Diabetes and Metabolism, Queen Elizabeth University Hospital, Glasgow.

Professor Baird has been in an academic for over 40 years and has worked in several Universities in the UK and abroad before returning to Glasgow Caledonian University in 1995. He is respected nationally and internationally in the field of diabetes and diabetic foot disease and is held in high esteem by his profession and his peers for his commitment to Podiatric Medicine in the United Kingdom and Internationally. He has delivered diabetic foot programmes and keynote lectures in over 30 countries around the world including Europe, India, the Middle East and Far East.
